

The Grand Rapids Combined Theatre Scholarship Fund was founded in 1985 to award college scholarships to students pursuing study in theatre arts. It is supported by ongoing contributions from individuals in the community, and by annual support from Actor's Theatre, Community Circle Theatre, Grand Rapids Civic Theatre, Heritage Theatre, Jewish Theatre, and Master Arts Theatre.

<u>Amount of Awards</u>: Scholarships generally ranging from **\$1,000 to \$2,000** are awarded annually to individuals who by their own contribution to theatre have demonstrated ability, talent, and dedication to the theatre arts.

<u>Application Criteria</u>: Applicants must be enrolled full time in an accredited college or training program located within the United States with preference being given to theatre arts majors. Applicants must have experience in any Grand Rapids area community theatre venue. Finalists may be contacted for an interview as part of the selection process. The decision made by the panel of judges shall be final and will be based on the information contained in the application, any attached documentation and/or the interview.

<u>Award Payment</u>: Awards will be paid directly to the recipient's school upon verification of enrollment. This is an annual competitive award. Previous applicants and recipients may reapply each year. No person is eligible to receive a Combined Theatre Scholarship more than twice.

**Letters of Reference**: Attach **three current letters of reference**, one of which must be from an instructor/director of a performing theatre group.
